1. Purpose

The purpose of the Community Leadership Council (CLC) is to unite diverse supporters of our organization so they can work together to further the mission of SPSF NWA.

2. Membership

Anyone who supports the mission of Single Parent Scholarship Fund of Northwest Arkansas and wishes to promote the organization is eligible to join the Community Leadership Council. Potential members are asked to submit an application for consideration. Upon selection to the CLC, members are expected to make an annual financial contribution and/or connect the Single Parent Scholarship Fund of NWA development team to philanthropic resources within their respective network.

3. Activities of the Community Leadership Council

The Community Leadership Council has several opportunities to support SPSF NWA each year. Each member is asked to participate in a **minimum of one activity during the year**. Activities include:

- participate in applicant interviews;
- support the organization's fundraising activities;
- contribute skills and resources for SPSF NWA events and activities;
- speak on behalf of the organization at community events;
- serve as honorary hosts of SPSF NWA special events;
- promote SPSF NWA to others who might be interested in supporting our organization.

If a CLC member is inactive for a period of one year, he/she will be removed. In addition, CLC members will be invited to re-commit each year.
